To assure that donations are appropriate for our preschool audience, we ask that books adhere to the following guidelines:

- Please select books that are new, like new, or gently used.

- We accept both board books and picture books. Please, no chapter books, activity books, workbooks or coloring books.
- As a non-sectarian organization, Ready Readers asks that you refrain from donating books that feature religious holidays or religious themes.
